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

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on November 19, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Met-Ed initiated discovery on February 5, 2019. Mr. List did not respond to Met-Ed's discovery by either objection or response to the questions. On March 5, 2019, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Compel. On March 15, 2019, Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson granted the Motion to Compel and directed Mr. List to submit full and complete responses no later than April 8, 2019. Mr. List failed to timely respond to Met-Ed's discovery, and no response or objection has been received to date. Further, Mr. List has failed to provide notification of his expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the November 19, 2018 Interim Order. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses. Due to Mr. List's lack of response to discovery and other procedural deadlines, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Dismiss on April 23, 2019. The Motion remains pending. In fact, the only communication received from Mr. List since Met-Ed received his complaints is a letter dated May 2, 2019 in which Mr. List notes that he believes moving his case forward would be "pointless".

At this point, Met-Ed believes that a ruling on its Motion to Dismiss is appropriate. In the alternative, Met-Ed suggests that it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine Mr. List's intent in moving his complaint forward.


