Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on May 23, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). As of the date of this report, the parties have exchanged preliminary discovery in this matter. In addition, Met-Ed has provided notification of its proposed witnesses. On May 15, 2019, a prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson. At that prehearing conference, the Complainant was given a further extension until May 30, 2019 to notify Met-Ed of its witnesses. On May 30, Met-Ed reported that its witness list remained unchanged. No witness notification has been received from Ms. Distefano. At this point, Met-Ed is of the expectation that Ms. Distefano will not present any testimony other than her own at an evidentiary hearing in this matter. To that end, Met-Ed has no need to conduct further discovery related to this case. Further, Met-Ed will revise its witness list such that only the testimony of John C. Ahr will be presented.

The May 23 Interim Order also required that a status report be submitted, setting out the availability of the parties for hearings in this matter during the weeks identified by the order. Met-Ed's availability for days during which its counsel and witness will be available. Given that it is expected that only Ms. Distefano and Mr. Ahr will testify, it is believed that only one day will be necessary for the in-person hearing to be held in Harrisburg. The dates that Met-Ed is available include August 27, 28, 29, and September 3.

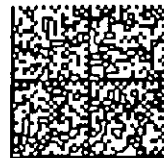
