OBJECTION TO RESPONDENT’S MOTION TO DISMISS

AND NOW comes Diana Sabatine, a woman, as herself, a human being, and not a fictitious entity, **files this *Objection to Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss*** by West Penn Power Company, First Energy Corporation, and First Energy Service Company (“West Penn” or the “Company”) to Diana Sabatine, dated June 21, 2019, and received by First Class Mail on Monday, June 24, 2019.

Complainant wishes to object to every enumerated item stated in Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss:

- A. A pre-hearing conference ***is not a hearing of evidence*** but to arrange the schedule of the hearing. It seems that #49 in the *Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss* dated June 21, 2019 is stated as such to sway the judge with an inane request.
- B. Complainant does not recall receiving notification of a pre-hearing conference, It was ***not*** intentional on Complainant’s part to miss the pre-hearing conference. A people’s right cannot be taken away due to a technical error either by fault of the Complainant or the provider.
- C. Complainant does not recall receiving a hard copy of notification of a pre-hearing conference from the letter carrier who provides mail delivery.


- D. Complainant does not recall receiving information to prompt her to mark the date and time on her calendar for the pre-hearing conference.
- E. Complainant did not hear or see a call on her telephone that others were waiting for Complainant to enter a call for a pre-hearing conference on or about June 4, 2019. Complainant became aware of the pre-hearing conference after listening to a voicemail later that day.
- F. Only at the time Complainant heard a voicemail from a man who identified himself as “Dan”, Judge Watson’s legal assistant, did Complainant become aware of a pre-hearing conference. Complainant did in fact call Dan back immediately after listening to a voicemail. Complainant explained to Dan that Complainant did not recall receiving notification for a pre-hearing conference. Complainant told Dan that if she had answered the call, she would have said that she is *still waiting to receive in writing an answer from this court to Complainant’s Fourth Amended Notice and Petition to Challenge Jurisdiction with requested relief, dated and filed with Secretary Rosemary Chiavetta on February 5, 2019 along with a Notice to Plead to Respondent in which Respondent remained silent.* Also, a letter was sent Gladys Brown, Chairman of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission regarding the *Fourth Amended Notice and Petition to Challenge Jurisdiction* in which a response is still pending.
- G. At this time Complainant does not have any expert or factual witnesses other than ourselves, but we reserve the right to amend that.
- H. We remind this court that Complainant is not an attorney or a lawyer, but a woman, as herself, a human being, and not a fictitious entity. If Complainant recalled that a pre-hearing conference was scheduled, Complainant would have placed a reminder on her calendar to prepare and attend this due process portion of the proceeding.

Therefore, Complainant requests Judge Watson to ***deny Respondent’s Request for Motion to Dismiss*** and ***grant an extension of time for a pre-hearing conference in the above referenced docket number so that this court can answer Complainant with a response to the Fourth Amended Notice and Petition to Challenge Jurisdiction dated and filed with***

Secretary Rosemary Chiavetta on February 5, 2019 and sent to this court and Respondent(s) as noted in *letter F.* of this *Objection to Respondent's Motion to Dismiss.*
