Mr. Lauchnor is a property owner whose property is crossed by an existing transmission line owned by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric"), which is the subject of the above captioned Letter of Notification.


In his letter, Mr. Lauchnor expressed concern with the impact that the proposed project might have on his property. Upon receipt of his letter, the Company established a meeting with Mr. Lauchnor on June 10, 2019, to review the project, discuss the potential impacts to his property, and address his concerns. PPL Electric does not believe that there will be any significant negative impacts to Mr. Lauchnor's property, particularly environmental impacts, and no additional easements or waivers are necessary as to his property in order to accommodate the project. Further, PPL Electric believes that this project will actually have a positive impact on Mr. Lauchnor's property, as his property currently supports two H-frame structures that will be replaced by a single steel monopole.

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The Company believes that it has addressed and resolved Mr. Lauchnor's concerns. However, to the extent Mr. Lauchnor has any further concerns about the impact of this project on his property, PPL Electric has and will continue to work with Mr. Lauchnor to address those concerns.
