SECTION 1 RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS and RELATED ARTICLES, IN USE, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), supplements thereto and reissues thereof, published by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are person effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 40 - LABOR CHARGES

Labor charges cover all accessorial services for which no charges are otherwise provided in this tariff, when such services are requested by shipper.

SECTION 3

HOURLY RATES

ITEM 200

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS transported distances of forty (40) miles and less as authorized in Scope of Carrier's Operating Authority.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the <u>TRANSPORTATION CHARGES</u> on any shipment shall be a <u>COMBINATION</u> of the applicable <u>TRAVELING CHARGE</u> named in Column 1 plus <u>HOURLY CARGE</u> at the applicable rates named in Columns 2 and 3.

Hourly rates apply only from the arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) <u>until</u> completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 1: Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2 and 3).

NOTE 2: Hourly rates (Columns 2 and 3) are based on the day or days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3: Hourly rates (Columns 2 and 3) computed in half-hour periods; fraction of one-half hour considered one-half hour.

NOTE 4: When a holiday fails on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall be applicable. Minimum total

transportation charges on Sundays and holidays - eight (8) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2.

▲ NOTE 5: Traveling charges will be based on one (1) hour at the applicable hourly rate when distance from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal is 0-20 miles. When distance from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal is 21-40 miles, traveling charge will be one and one-half (1 1/2) hours. If distance from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal is 21-40 miles, traveling charge will be one and one-half (1 1/2) hours. If distance from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal exceeds forty (40) miles, an additional traveling charge of one-half (1/2) hour per each additional fifteen (15) miles will be assessed. NOTE 6: Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisor as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.
