## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS**

Advance reservations must be made 24 hours prior to the service being rendered.

### **STANDARD RATES**

Rates for rides begin from the time vehicle leaves carrier's place of business and ends at the time vehicle returns to carrier's place of business.

### **HOLIDAY RATES**

Service provided during the following holidays and until 7:00 AM the following day will be subjected to an additional charge: New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Thanksgiving Eve, and Thanksgiving.

### **ADDITIONAL EXPENSES**

All bridge, road, and tunnel tolls, parking/entrance fees, and other out-of-pocket expenses shall be the responsibility of the customer and will be added onto carrier's charges.

### **CONTRACT**

Contract services will be for a term of not less than 30 days for pre-qualified persons under a federal, state, county or municipal government agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts, copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

### **DEPOSITS**

1. Carrier requires a deposit of not more than 20% of the quoted charter price. Forfeiture of deposits are within the following limitations:
  - (1) Forfeiture of not more than 50% of the deposit if the charter is cancelled by the customer more than 15 but less than 30 days prior to the date the transportation was to depart, and
  - (2) Forfeiture of not more than the total amount of the deposit if the cancellation occurs within 15 days prior to the date the transportation was to depart.
