Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please allow this letter to serve as Metropolitan Edison Company's ("Met-Ed" or the "Company") response to Complainant's Motion to Compel Discovery filed by Conchita M. Braun on July 8, 2019. The Complainant avers that the Company failed to provide a full and complete response to Question 22 of Complainant's Set I Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents ("Discovery Requests") as ordered by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson and that the Company failed to respond to Question 12 of Complainant's Set II Discovery Requests as it erroneously reiterated the question and its response to Question 12 of Complainant's Set I Discovery Requests.

With regard to the Complainant's allegations of lack of full and complete response to Question 22 of Set I Discovery Requests, the Company avers that its response to Complainant's Set I Discovery Requests, Question 22 is responsive to all portions of the question and the Company directed the Complainant to public documents in support of its response and in response to the final portion of Question 22 requesting where the information is located. The fact that the Complainant does not like or understand the response is not indicative of the Company being unresponsive.

With regard to the Complainant's allegation that the Company erroneously responded to Question 12 of Set I Discovery Requests rather than Question 12 of Set II Discovery Requests, the Complainant is correct that an error was inadvertently made by the Company. In order to correct the Company's error, the Company is providing a detailed response to the Complainant for Question 12, under a separate cover letter, no later than close of business on Friday, July 19, 2019.


