TUS-3 Reference TUS Data Requests, Response to TUS-2. Please provide the name of the individual or entity that will pay any project costs that exceed the quote (\$100,594.85) provided to Allegheny County Airport Authority.

Response:

The License Agreement is a fixed price contract based on an engineering estimate to construct the designed solution. The price provided in the Agreement is not subject to adjustment unless the scope of work is modified. The Airport Authority is required to pay the contract price up-front and Duquesne Light will begin construction once payment and the necessary Commission approval is received.

In the event the project costs more than the estimate, the excess would be considered an increase to Duquesne Light Company's property, plant and equipment balances. On the other hand, if the project costs less than the estimate, the credit would be considered a decrease to Duquesne Light Company's property, plant and equipment balances.
