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

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TURBOTVILLE, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1-18 AND ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES, AND SETTING NEW USER CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED FROM THE OWNER OF EACH IMPROVED PROPERTY SERVED BY THE SEWER SYSTEM

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Turbotville (the "Borough") owns, operates and maintains a wastewater system located within the Borough of Turbotville, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that furnishes water and wastewater services to the public in various counties throughout Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Borough entered into a joint agreement with the Municipal Authority of the Borough of Turbotville (the "Authority") and PAWC dated June 29, 2019, for the Authority to sell the water system owned by the Authority to PAWC and for the Borough to sell the wastewater system owned by the Borough to PAWC (the "Asset Purchase Agreement") and

WHEREAS, the Purchase Agreement recites specific billing rates that must be enacted prior to closing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Turbotville, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The aforesaid Recitals are incorporated in this Ordinance as if repeated here.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1-18, Ordinance 11-12, Ordinance No. 2-09, Ordinance No. 99-04 and Ordinance 90-5 as amended, which set forth the annual flat rate user charge payable for an equivalent dwelling unit is hereby amended to provide the following charges for all metered customers subject to a monthly service per equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) as follows:

A. Residential

Service Charge per month:	\$ 7.50
Usage Charge per 100 gallons:	\$ 1.2880

B. Commercial

Service Charge per month:	\$ 20.00
Usage Charge per 100 gallons:	\$ 1.1194

C. Industrial

Service Charge per month: \$ 20.00
Usage Charge per 100 gallons: \$ 1.1194

D. Municipal

Service Charge per month: \$ 20.00
Usage Charge per 100 gallons: \$ 1.1194

E. Unmetered Charges

A flat rate for customers not metered for water consumption as follows:

1. Residential and Commercial

Flat rate per month, per EDU: \$58.50

SECTION 3. All ordinances or part thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
