On July 23, 2019, West Penn Power Company (“West Penn”) was served with a hearing notice setting this matter for an evidentiary hearing on September 5, 2019 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. While West Penn’s counsel and witnesses had been available on that date at the time of its status report submitted on June 3, 2019, the Company’s counsel and one witness have since become unavailable, and updated availability had been provided to Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Jeffrey A. Watson’s legal clerk for scheduling purposes.

Unbeknownst to West Penn, this matter had been transferred to the Harrisburg office for scheduling, which office did not have the Company’s updated availability for hearing purposes at the time that this matter was scheduled for the impending hearing. Upon receipt of that notice, counsel for West Penn contacted ALJ Watson’s legal clerk, and was advised to contact Mr. Adams to ascertain his alternative availability. Unfortunately, while counsel and Mr. Adams were able to connect, Mr. Adams has advised that he is refusing to provide any alternative dates so that this matter may be rescheduled for a mutually agreeable date.

As such, the Company respectfully requests that this matter be continued and set for another date. In support of that request, West Penn notes that its counsel and witnesses are collectively available on the following dates for a rescheduled hearing: September 12; October 1-2, 8-10, 22-24, and 29-31; and November 5-7, 12-14 and 19-20.
