Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order Requiring Further Status Report to Address Stipulation or to Schedule an Evidentiary Hearing issued on June 27, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("Company"). On June 28, 2019, the Company contacted Mr. Sabatini *via* telephone, at the two phone numbers listed on the Formal Complaint, at 1:00 p.m. as agreed to by the parties at the June 26, 2019 prehearing conference. The Company left messages at both numbers and received a phone call back from Mr. Sabatini fifteen minutes later. Unfortunately, the Company and Mr. Sabatini were not able to come to an agreement with regard to entering into a Stipulation. Therefore, this matter should be moved towards an evidentiary hearing. However, as the Company noted in its May 2, 2019 Status Report as well as at the June 26, 2019 prehearing conference, the Complainants did not submit their witness notification as required by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson's Interim Order dated December 19, 2018. As of this date, the Company has still yet to receive the Complainants' witness notification. Therefore, the Company respectfully requests that the Complainants not be allowed to submit any witness testimony besides their own testimony and that this matter be scheduled for an evidentiary hearing.


