In compliance with the Order Granting Continuance issued in this matter on June 7, 2019, Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") files this status report.

The Order Granting Continuance granted PAWC's request to continue the litigation schedule in this matter because the Commission had not yet issued a decision on PAWC's Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action concerning the Secretarial Letter issued on May 8, 2019. By Order entered July 11, 2019, the Commission denied that Petition.

The Parties continue to discuss a possible settlement of this proceeding. In the event that a settlement cannot be achieved, PAWC, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. have agreed to the following schedule:


