7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.

At least sixty days (60) prior to the security instrument's expiration date, Applicant should contact Stephen Jakab at sjakab@pa.gov to determine the appropriate bonding amount based on a percentage of Applicant's gross receipts resulting from the sale of generated electricity consumed in Pennsylvania. Reports must be filed using the appropriate report form that may be obtained from the PUC's Secretary's Bureau or the forms officer, or may be down-loaded from the PUC's internet web site.
- Reports of Gross Receipts: Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
- The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

- d. **TRANSFER OF LICENSE:** The Applicant understands that if it plans to transfer its license to another entity, it is required to request authority from the Commission for permission prior to transferring the license. See 66 Pa. C.S. Section 2809(D). Transferee will be required to file the appropriate licensing application.

ELECTRIC SUPPLIER CERTIFICATE

This 10th day of September 2013, the Delaware Public Service Commission (the "Commission") determines and orders the following:

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2013, pursuant to 26 *Del. C.* §1001 - §1020, the Electric Utility Restructuring Act (the "Act"), and 26 *Del. Admin. C.* §3001, the Commission's Rules for Certification and Regulation of Electric Suppliers (the "Supplier Rules"), United Power Consultants, Inc. (the "Company") filed an application (the "Application") seeking certification as a retail electric supplier in order to broker the sale or purchase of Electric Supply Service;¹ and

WHEREAS, in its Application, the Company states that it is seeking certification as a Broker² that will utilize appropriate

energy procurement strategies to meet the needs of residential, commercial, and industrial customers in Delaware; and

WHEREAS, Staff reports that the Company's Application fulfills all of the requirements for an Electric Supplier Certificate to act as a Broker as set forth in the Act and the Supplier Rules. In particular, Staff reports that the Company appears to possess the financial, operational, managerial, and technical capabilities to operate as a Broker of Electric Supply Service. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an Electric Supplier Certificate authorizing the Company to broker sales and customer purchases of Electric Supply Services in the State of Delaware;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:

1. United Power is hereby granted a certificate to do business and operate as an "Electric Supplier" (Broker) within the State of Delaware. Under this Electric Supplier Certificate, United Power is authorized to broker Electric Supply Service within the State of Delaware consistent with and in accordance with the Act and the Supplier Rules.

2. United Power shall at all times provide its brokerage of Electric Supply Service in accordance with the requirements imposed by the Act and the Supplier Rules as presently adopted, or as may be hereafter amended or supplemented. United Power is hereby notified that a violation of any applicable order, statute, regulation, rule, or other controlling authority may be

enforced by the sanctions permitted by §§1012(a) and 1019 of the Act and §3001-10.2 of the Supplier Rules.

3. United Power shall file such reports and pay such fees and assessments as may be required or imposed by §§114, 115, and 1012(c)(2) of the Act and §§3001-3.9 and 3.10 of the Supplier Rules.

4. United Power consents to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Delaware for all acts or omissions related to its offering of Electric Supply Service within this State.

5. United Power is hereby placed on notice that the costs of the proceedings will be charged to it pursuant to §114(b)(1) of the Act.

6. The Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.

ORDER

By the Commission:

I. INTRODUCTION

On March 27, 2014, United Power Consultants, Inc. (“Applicant”) filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant (“ABC”) in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act (“Act”), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" (“Part 454”). Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois. Upon review of the application, Staff of the Commission (“Staff”) requested additional information and clarification of certain matters. On July 8, 2014, Applicant filed an Amended Application. Since all of the information to grant the requested relief was contained in the application, the Hearing was waived.

II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Florida and authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers’ data. The Applicant has also attested that no complaints have been filed against it for its provision of services in the

electric or gas industry in the jurisdictions where it provides or is seeking to provide services.

III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Applicant is required by Section 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Section 454.60 through Attachment B. Attachment B contains a corporate organizational chart and identifies the occupational background information of the persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a). Attachment B also contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Section 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Section 454.70 with the information provided in Attachment B. Attachment B contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.70(a).

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, managerial, and financial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements. The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that United Power Consultants, Inc. is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) United Power Consultants, Inc., a business organized under the laws of Florida and authorized to transact business in Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) United Power Consultants, Inc. has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial, and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) United Power Consultants, Inc. has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) United Power Consultants, Inc. should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that United Power Consultants, Inc. is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that United Power Consultants, Inc. shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to United Power Consultants, Inc. (“UPC” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ The license for United Power Consultants, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On April 21, 2014, UPC filed its license application.² Specifically, UPC intends to operate as a broker of electricity for residential, commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia, pursuant to Section 34-1505 of the “Retail Electric Competition and Consumer Protection Act of 1999 (“Act”).”³ Pursuant to the Commission’s licensing requirements as set forth in Order No. 11796,⁴ UPC has provided the following information:

- a) Proof of technical and managerial competence;
- b) An affidavit of compliance with applicable Federal and District of Columbia environmental laws and regulations dated November 20, 2013;
- c) Proof of financial integrity to include financial statements;

- d) Proof that UPC has registered with the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to do business in the District of Columbia;
- e) An affidavit dated November 20, 2013, stating that UPC is subject to all applicable taxes;
- f) An affidavit dated November 20, 2013, stating that UPC will comply with all the requirements of all orders and regulations of the Commission; and
- g) Applicant's website address: <http://www.unitedpowerconsultants.com>.

UPC filed supplemental financial information on August 22, 2014.⁵

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in UPC's application, demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and the financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting UPC's application will serve the public interest. Accordingly UPC's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of United Power Consultants, Inc. for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The license for United Power Consultants, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.

I. SUMMARY

In this Order, we license United Power Consultants, Inc. to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On March 25, 2014, United Power Consultants, Inc. (UPC) applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. UPC proposes to provide aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine. UPC met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements. As a licensed competitive electricity provider, UPC is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports. To the extent that a licensed competitive electricity provider uses third-parties to assist in obtaining customers during the course of its business, Chapter 305 § 4(C) of the Commission's rules places the responsibility on the competitive electricity provider for violations of the provisions of this section by representatives or agents acting on the CEP's behalf. Chapter 305 § 2(C)(3) also requires a competitive electricity provider to use reasonable efforts not to conduct business with any entity acting as a competitive electricity provider in Maine without a license from the Commission. Therefore, if UPC uses a third party, it is responsible to ensure that the third party has met any licensing requirements of the Commission.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, *PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers*, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S., § 3203 (1)(2) and Chapter 305, § 2 to license competitive electricity providers. On September 12, 2009, in Docket No. 2009-260, statutory changes took effect that change the title of this position. P.L. 2009, ch. 122. The Director of Technical Analysis is now the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries. All existing delegation orders that delegate Commission authority to the Director of Technical Analysis will now read that we delegate our authority to the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries.

Accordingly, it is

O R D E R E D

1. That United Power Consultants, Inc. is hereby issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules, to provide aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine; and
2. That this license is effective on the date of this Order and valid until revoked or suspended by the Commission pursuant to section 3(A)(4) of Chapter 305, or abandoned by the licensee pursuant to sections 2(D)(10) and 2(D)(11) of Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS TO REVIEW OR APPEAL

5 M.R.S.A. § 9061 requires the Public Utilities Commission to give each party to an adjudicatory proceeding written notice of the party's rights to review or appeal of its decision made at the conclusion of the adjudicatory proceeding. The methods of review or appeal of PUC decisions at the conclusion of an adjudicatory proceeding are as follows:

1. Reconsideration of the Commission's Order may be requested under Section 1004 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (65-407 C.M.R.110) within 20 days of the date of the Order by filing a petition with the Commission stating the grounds upon which reconsideration is sought. Any petition not granted within 20 days from the date of filing is denied.
2. Appeal of a final decision of the Commission may be taken to the Law Court by filing, within 21 days of the date of the Order, a Notice of Appeal with the Administrative Director of the Commission, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(1)-(4) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure.
3. Additional court review of constitutional issues or issues involving the justness or reasonableness of rates may be had by the filing of an appeal with the Law Court, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(5).

Note: The attachment of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the particular document may be subject to review or appeal. Similarly, the failure of the Commission to attach a copy of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the document is not subject to review or appeal.
