Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Jeffrey A. Watson on July 5, 2019, Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed” or “Company”) offers this status report in the above-referenced matter.

On May 23, 2019, as a result of the parties participating in a prehearing conference, a revised litigation schedule was entered. Since the entry of that order, Ms. Armstrong has continually failed to participate in this proceeding as she again failed to provide notification of any witnesses she anticipates utilizing, failed to provide any response whatsoever to Met-Ed’s discovery requests in contradiction to ALJ Watson’s interim orders, and failed to submit any written direct testimony. As such, Met-Ed filed an Amended Motion to Dismiss on July 8, 2019. To date, no response has been received from Ms. Armstrong and Met-Ed believes that the Motion is ripe to be ruled upon.

Should Met-Ed’s Motion to Dismiss be denied or held in abeyance and an evidentiary hearing scheduled, Met-Ed requests that any evidentiary hearing deemed necessary be scheduled as a telephonic hearing. Given Ms. Armstrong’s presumed lack of expert testimony, it is believed that only one day of testimony will be necessary, and that the Company would only need to present the testimony of Mr. John C. Ahr. As such, counsel for Met-Ed and its witness are available in September or October 2019 as follows: September 9-13 and 16; or October 1-2, 4, 7-11, 15-16, 21-25 and 29-31.
