**RESPONDENT'S STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Interim Order Establishing Initial Litigation Schedule dated November 28, 2018 ("Scheduling Order"), Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") submits this status report:

1. In accordance with the Scheduling Order, Duquesne Light provided Complainant with a copy of its potential witness list on January 4, 2019.
2. Complainant has not yet provided Duquesne Light with a list of potential witnesses or expert reports.
3. Discovery closed on February 28, 2019 pursuant to the Scheduling Order.
4. On March 11, 2019, Duquesne Light filed a Status Report, as required by the Scheduling Order.
5. Complaint did not file a status report on or before March 11, 2019, or any time thereafter.
6. As required by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Interim Order dated June 25, 2019, Duquesne Light contacted its respective witnesses to identify the dates in which they will be available to provide testimony in this proceeding in October 2019.
7. Duquesne Light's witnesses are available from October 1-3, 2019.

8. Duquesne Light has no objection to conducting the hearing telephonically rather than in-person, as proposed by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge in the Interim Order dated June 25, 2019.

9. Duquesne Light respectfully requests that its expert witnesses be permitted to provide written direct testimony rather than live direct testimony, as permitted by 52 Pa. Code § 5.412.

10. Duquesne Light also respectfully requests that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge set the following deadlines: (1) submission of exhibits and exhibit list approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date; and (2) submission of motions in limine approximately four weeks prior to the hearing.
