

Certification is a testing process using the Commission approved Internet protocol. To initiate this process, the NGS is encouraged to contact the NGDC as early as possible after filing an application for a license with the Commission, since certification may require as many as four months to complete and customer service contract dates may not commence prior to certification. NGDC requirements of new suppliers may be found on the respective NGDC home web page. 


