Dear Secretary, Chiavetta:

On August 12th I received Metropolitan Edison Company's preliminary objection response to my complaint to the PUC (Docket No. C-2019-3011645) via US mail non-certified. Therefore, the date of August 8th set as my acceptance of their response is not accurate and must not be understood as the start of the 10-day response period. Addressing the in accurate statement on page 2 section #3 I was not contacted by Wellington Energy on October 30, 2018 at the service location because no one was physically at the service location that day, so the statement is false.

Again, I'm requesting a 12-month waiver from having a Smart Meter installed on my home to give me time to find an alternative source of electricity as stated in my initial complaint (solar, wind etc.). My constitutional rights afford me the right to deny this device as I look to alternate source of electricity as its been documented to cause tinnitus and other deleterious health issues.
