JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Interim Order Requiring Status Report dated July 24, 2019, Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") submits this Joint Status Report:

1. The parties have engaged in ongoing, good-faith settlement discussions and will continue to do so, but have been unable to resolve this matter at this time.
2. The parties do not request a further stay of this proceeding.
3. Daniel Eaby has agreed to review and provide additional responses to the seven discovery requests identified by Duquesne Light in the Motion to Compel Discovery Responses dated May 1, 2019 ("Motion to Compel"). The parties respectfully request that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge refrain from ruling on the Motion to Compel at this time. If Duquesne Light does not receive full and complete responses to all discovery requests identified in the Motion to Compel, it reserves the right to renew or refile the Motion to Compel.
4. Duquesne Light does not request an in-person hearing. Daniel Eaby requests an in-person hearing, but does not require that the in-person hearing be held in Harrisburg.


