
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

This letter serves as an update to the status report on behalf of Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec") provided on July 15, 2019. On July 29, 2019, an Interim Order Denying Complainant's Motion for Late Filing of Interrogatories to be Propounded on Pennsylvania Electric Company or in the Alternative Motion for Leave to File Interrogatories Out of Time was issued. Additionally, the Company avers that additional discovery responses were received from Ms. Dougherty in response to the Interim Order entered on June 19, 2019. As such, Penelec avers that discovery is now complete. Further, in light of the responses received from Ms. Dougherty to Penelec's Discovery Requests and witness identification, the Company's Motion to Dismiss is now moot.

Based upon the status report provided by Ms. Dougherty dated August 12, 2019, she and her witness are available for a telephonic hearing on October 22, 2019. Counsel for Penelec and its witnesses are available and agree with the scheduling of a telephonic hearing on October 22, 2019. Further, in anticipation of the evidentiary hearing, Penelec proposes that a deadline for written direct testimony and exhibits be set for September 15, 2019 and a deadline for written rebuttal testimony and exhibits be set for October 15, 2019.
