In response to Document 1630385:

Joseph and Suzanne have been unable to secure expert witnesses for the complaints put forward.

Therefore we plan on presenting the evidence, pro se.

Of the many concerns put forward in our complaint of smart meter technology, we plan on limiting evidence to two issues only.

1. Lack of a common mode filter on the Itron meter and the subsequent injection of voltage transients into house wiring causing 'dirty electricity' radiation throughout the house. This condition is objectionable and inferior to our existing analogue meter which does not distort the house power sine wave.
2. Radio frequency radiation hazards at the meter, being caused by the utilities incorrect installation of the meter.

Having solid evidence for both issues, we feel confident in presenting factual information to the court.
