RESTRICTIVE AMENDMENT

AND NOW, come Washington Hose Company No.1 (hereinafter "Applicant") and Rover Community Transportation, Inc. (hereinafter "Protestant"), by and through their undersigned counsel, and file this restrictive amendment as follows:

1. The above captioned application is hereby amended to clearly identify and specify the territory requested so that the authority sought shall read as follows:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in non-emergency medical paratransit service, from points in Chester County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

2. Based upon the Restrictive Amendment set forth in Paragraph 1 above, and conditioned upon its acceptance by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), any order being issued being consistent therewith, Protestant agrees to withdraw its protest to the Application as amended. Protestant desires to remain a party of record so as to receive copies of any order issued by the Commission in this proceeding.

3. The Restrictive Amendment is in the public interest because Applicant is seeking to augment its existing stretcher service by providing cost effective non-emergency transportation to the people of Chester County in vans in order to meet its program requirements.

4. If the Restrictive Amendment is not accepted by the Commission, the parties agree that further hearings shall be held to permit the parties to present evidence in support and opposition to the Application.

WHEREFORE, the parties, intending to be legally bound, have hereunto set their hands and seals as of this 27th day of August, 2019.
