MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING


Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”), hereby submits this request for a continuance of the hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Wednesday, September 4, 2019. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By Notice dated July 16, 2019, the Commission scheduled an In-Person Hearing in this matter for Wednesday, September 4, 2019 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Christopher Pell.
2. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a) and the Prehearing Order that was issued on July 23, 2019, PGW has contacted Ms. Walker and is attempting to reach a settlement in this matter.
3. It is unlikely that a resolution will be reached prior to the scheduled hearing date.
4. PGW has spoken with Ms. Walker and discussed the need for a continuance in this matter.


