**Reference PPL case: C-2018-3005582 Hearing: Date September 26, 2019, 11am.**

I wish to request a reschedule of the above case's hearing date currently scheduled for September, 2019, until a later date in 2020 for the following reasons.

Unfortunately, I have recently injured my shoulder, and I am experiencing acute pain in the shoulder and upper left arm. I had an appointment at Lancaster Orthopedics last week, and had x-rays. I am now on a course of treatment with a follow-up due on **September 23 2019** with surgeon Doctor M.Gish, (**see attached**) in which I expect further treatment & care over that following week depending on the outcome of that consultation. The pain is acute and can vary during the day, but it is at its worst in the early to mid-morning.

In addition, having a young family with a new-born, and working fulltime and most often in the evenings as my employer is located overseas in a NZ time zone – has meant that it is difficult right now to adequately complete my preparation for these (two) hearings. September is now squaring up to be a very busy month for the bank I contract to, and I am working most evenings. I just received more responses and documents from PPL (last few days) and they are very extensive in nature & will need considerable time to read through and address.

Our nearly 5 month old new-born, who, (as expected), is waking in the night, means as parents, we are very stretched at the moment.

In respect to the above would you please consider rescheduling the hearing, *so that I can avoid the time around the follow-up consultations & fully heal from the shoulder injury?*

This will also allow time for the baby to settle into a better sleep routine. I can then provide the due attention this case requires. I need to avoid at least 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2020 as I may have an extended business trip to NZ around that time.

I very much appreciate your understanding and consideration in this matter.
