I am a concerned resident of Pittsburgh, PA. I would like to submit my comments regarding the rulemaking of hazardous liquid standards.

Regarding construction, pipelines should be farther away from public places, especially schools.

There should be a review of national and international best practices, based on the places with the least amount of pipeline incidents or complaints per capita, to determine what is the most recommended distance from public spaces.

"Public/high traffic" areas include schools, parks, libraries, beaches, etc. This is to protect the public from incidences of leakage or explosion.

Additionally, I would like to recommend that construction of pipeline through waterways is done with practices that are the absolute least susceptible to leaks, regardless of cost. This will reduce the repeated and overall environmental damage of future leaks and repairs/maintenance.

Thank you for your hard work and I trust you will keep the needs of the environmental health of citizens in mind as you go through these proceedings.

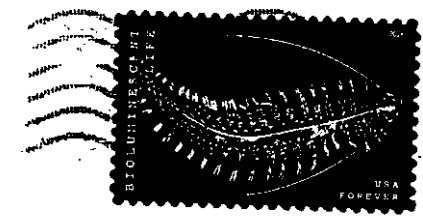
