Hello, I hope this letter finds you well.

I understand that you have the daunting task of weeding through applications and enforcing policies. I thought that with my response, I might tell you a little more about our company and what we are all about. I hope that's ok with you and I hope to not take too much of your time, but the future of our company is reliant on obtaining our PUC operating authority. It is important to me, as the owner of this company, to explain why this operating authority means so much to our company.

Indian Valley Trading Company was started over three years ago by me (Daniel Ireland) with an idea to help as many people in our community as possible and beyond. I started off small, assisting the elderly clear out their space, pack boxes, organize and downsize into their new homes. I assisted with removing trash, junk and recyclable materials as well. I also began to receive a lot of furniture donations, which I decided to give back what I could to other people in need in our area. There was a great response from our community and Indian Valley Trading Company began to grow.

A little more about me, I am an eighteen year active member of the Pennsylvania Emergency Services Community. I hold the rank of career Captain at Harleysville Area EMS which serves the largest area of Northern Montgomery County in PA. I also have over ten years of Pro Board certified firefighting and rescue experience in the state of PA.

I bring this up because you asked for experience with a household goods carrier or equivalent, which I have but I wanted to shine light on whom I am and who is working for me as well. The other reason for starting this business was to help not only the people in our community, but the forgotten people as well. The people who leave their homes day after day and night after night and face the most dangerous situations in our Commonwealth. Police/Fire and EMS, our emergency personnel. For us in Montgomery County, we lost over six members of our emergency service community to suicide in one year. This was very hard for a lot of us to deal with and we started to wonder why and if we were next! Even though small, I had an idea that I could incorporate members of the emergency service community into Indian Valley Trading Company to help them take a break from the day to day stressful situations of their regular job and help people in another way and still make good money doing it. To this day, after several years, we have multiple members of the Emergency Services community working for Indian Valley Trading Company who have stated that they are happier than ever helping people in our community in other ways. Indian Valley Trading Company also donates a percentage of each job back to local EMS/Fire or Police companies or charities to raise awareness of depression and suicide in the workplace or to simply purchase equipment that is otherwise not affordable.

If you can imagine a group of emergency service workers fighting every second on a scene to save someone's life, making life altering medical decisions and facilitating the movement of apparatus for the most positive outcome of a human life, then maybe you can understand this same group of people moving furniture, securing loads for best weight distribution and facilitating the movement of another family's home from one place to another, comes pretty easy.

When Indian Valley Trading Company first started, we had a lot of requests for moving but we were not quite there yet. Then I looked into it a little bit and realized that PA has a 2 year experience

requirement. Although I am confused as to why this is a requirement, I understand at the same time. Indian Valley Trading Company began to provide moving services for people outside of PA until we had enough experience to obtain our PUC authority to help the residence in our own community. (Over two years experience) We are a registered household goods carrier through the FMCSA (DOT # 3141629)(MC 99608) We were able to provide services in states that fall under FMCSA guidelines for household goods carrier. We obtained the proper insurance immediately for household goods, others cargo and our workforce.(copies included) We wanted to do everything correct and now we would like to assist our own community in Pennsylvania as well. That is why this operating authority is so very important to me and my company. We hope to obtain our operating authority in PA so we can add moving to our list of services that we can provide for our great community and further assist our emergency service community and the people who are behind the flashing lights.
