**ANSWER TO COMPLAINT**

1. First Class Coach, Inc. is a legal entity, operating under Certificate of Public Convenience approved and issued by Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission A-6414286 on August 2, 2012. The company is properly insured with Progressive, Policy No.02972731-6. In order to operate, Surety Bond is not required to be filed every year. Copy of Certificate and proof of Insurance is attached collectively hereto as Exhibit A.
2. On September 14, 2016, First Class Coach, Inc. was granted Brokerage License to operate as a broker, to arrange for the transportation of passengers, between points in Pennsylvania. It was issued by Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, A-6414286. In order to operate, Surety Bond has to be renewed every year. It was renewed in 2017 and 2018. There was no activity for these 3 years. That is why surety bond was not renewed due to inactivity and no earnings or profit. Copy of Brokerage License is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
3. Both licenses have the same A number, which caused this confusion A-6414286, but different authority number and issuance date: Certificate of Public Convenience - A-2012-2290409, and Brokerage License - A-2016-2537679.
4. First Class Coach maintains principal place of business at 301 Heights Lane. #42C, Feasterville, PA 19053

**WHEREFORE,**

1. Please discontinue the Brokerage License. Application for Approval of Abandonment or Discontinuance of Service was submitted to Evan Riccardo, Compliance Specialist. Copy of the Application is attached hereto as Exhibit C.
2. Please keep Certificate of Public Convenience active.
3. Please withdraw the penalty of \$500, since First Class Coach, Inc. did not violate law and did not perform illegal activity.

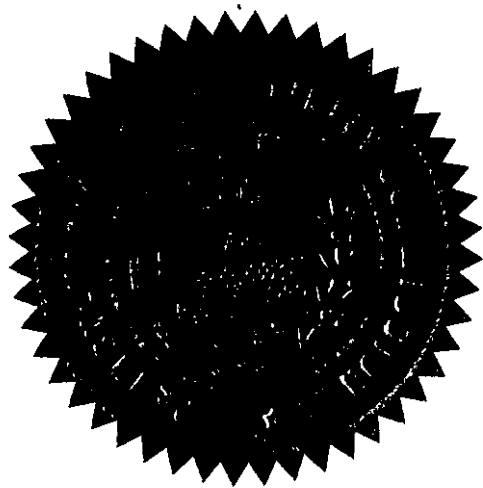



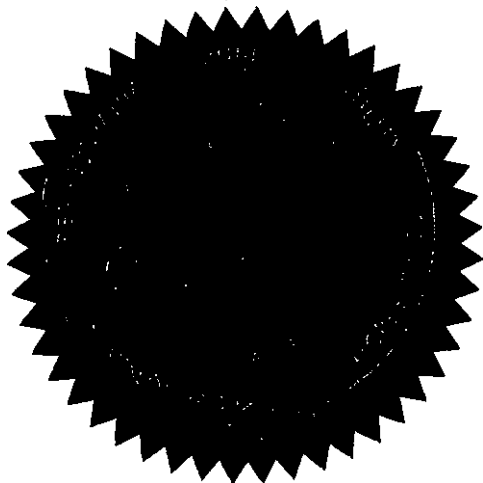
