
In accordance with the Interim Order issued on July 22, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed") as counsel for Met-Ed has not been successful in reaching Mr. and Mrs. Rieger to discuss the impending evidentiary hearing.

Mr. and Mrs. Rieger did not submit any written direct testimony and, therefore, Met-Ed advised on June 26, 2019, that it would not be submitting written rebuttal testimony and reserved its' right to respond to any testimony presented by the Complainants and permitted into the record at the evidentiary hearing.

Met-Ed advises that it wishes to have any evidentiary hearing scheduled as a telephonic hearing. Further, counsel for Met-Ed and its witnesses will be available to provide testimony in this proceeding during the month of October from [October 1-3, 9-10, 15-16, and 22-24, and November 5-7 or 12-14].



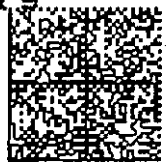
