

By Letter dated August 29, 2019, Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. ("IGS") petitioned the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") to maintain its reduced bonding level (5% of gross annual operating revenues) for the next bond period. This Amendment has redacted information and does not contain any **CONFIDENTIAL** information. That letter contained an error regarding the expiration date of IGS' current bond, which was represented as being November 2018, when in fact the correct date is November of 2019. 
