
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On behalf of Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), enclosed is a check for one-hundred dollars (\$100.00). This is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Rasier is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Rasier at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation as a Transportation Network Company ("TNC"). Rasier does not dispute the allegation that it is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction as a TNC.

The Complaint also alleges that Rasier is in violation of 52 Pa. Code § 29.402(1) of the Commission's regulations, which pertains to jurisdictional common and contract carriers. Without admitting liability under this provision, Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding the requested amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
