PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) respectfully requests a continuance of the hearing scheduled for October 3, 2019, at 11:00 AM, in the above-captioned proceeding until October 17, 2019, at 9:00 AM because one of PPL Electric’s witnesses, Donald Vinciguerra, can no longer attend the hearing on October 3, 2019.

On August 16, 2019, I left a detailed voicemail for Frances Demianczyk (“Complainant”) about, among other things, rescheduling the hearing. Later that day, I spoke with the Complainant’s husband about other topics involving the case. On August 22, 2019, the Complainant and I spoke, and she stated that she would be available for a hearing on October 15, 2019, at 11:00 AM. However, PPL Electric subsequently determined that a hearing on October 17, 2019, at 9:00 AM would be better given the current scheduling of hearings in other cases. As of submitting this letter, I have not heard back from the Complainant about the Company’s request to reschedule the hearing for October 17, 2019, at 9:00 AM.
