Please accept this letter on behalf as Discount Power, Inc ("DPI"), license docket number A-2012-2328004, to reduce its required level of financial security to 5% of its most recent 12 months of gross receipts, consistent with the directives of the Secretarial Letter issued on April 8, 2016 in the above referenced docket. DPI's current expiration date for its security is November 23, 2019. DPI's estimate of its most recent 12 month 5% gross receipt calculation is \$162,369.00


Please find the following information and documentation in support of DPI's Letter Petition:

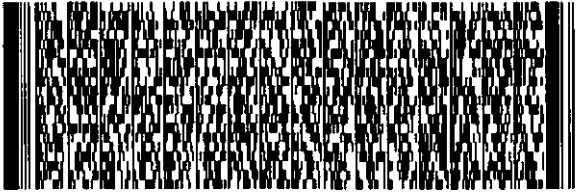

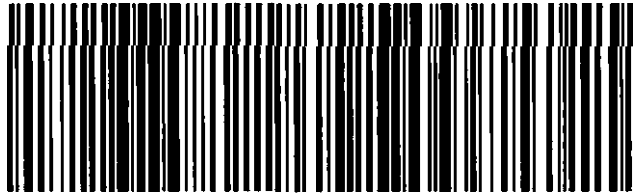
