
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. An in-person hearing for this matter is scheduled to take place on Friday, October 4 at 10:00 a.m.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the October 4 hearing date because of the unavailability of PECO counsel.
3. PECO Counsel is unable to attend this hearing due to a mandatory, pre-paid and out of state firm retreat. The retreat is scheduled for October 3 through October 5.
4. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
5. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted "in rare situations where good cause exists." (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).
