RESPONDENT’S SECOND STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge’s Interim Order Granting in Part Complainant’s Second Request for an Extension of Time to the Established Litigation Schedule (“Scheduling Order”), Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) submits this status report:

1. Under the Scheduling Order, any party wishing to factual testimony of any party other than Complainant was required to provide, in writing, the name and business address of that person(s) and a written summary of the expected testimony of that person(s) on or before August 12, 2019. The Scheduling Order also stated that any party wishing to present expert testimony was required to provide to the other party, in writing, the name and business address of that expert(s) and a written summary of the expected testimony of that expert(s) on or before August 12, 2019.

2. Duquesne Light previously provided Complainant with a copy of its witness list on February 1, 2019. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, Duquesne Light served Complainant with a Supplemental List of Potential Witnesses on August 12, 2019.

3. On February 1, 2019, Complainant served a document on Duquesne Light stating that he was attempting to identify witnesses but had not done so yet. On August 12,

2019, Complainant sent another document to Duquesne Light stating that he had not identified any witnesses for the hearing because "it is still premature in my active case." As of the date of this Second Status Report, Complainant still has not identified any fact or expert witnesses.

4. Pursuant to the Presiding ALJ's Interim Order Granting Motion of Duquesne Light Company to Compel Responses to Interrogatories and Document Requests, Complainant must provide certain supplemental discovery responses to Duquesne Light on or before October 7, 2019.

5. The parties have no other pending deadlines.

6. The parties have been engaged in good-faith settlement discussions.

7. If Duquesne Light does not file a dispositive motion or if its motion is denied, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that any new scheduling order incorporate the following deadlines: (1) submission of exhibits and exhibit list approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date; and (2) submission of motions in limine approximately four weeks prior to the hearing.
