

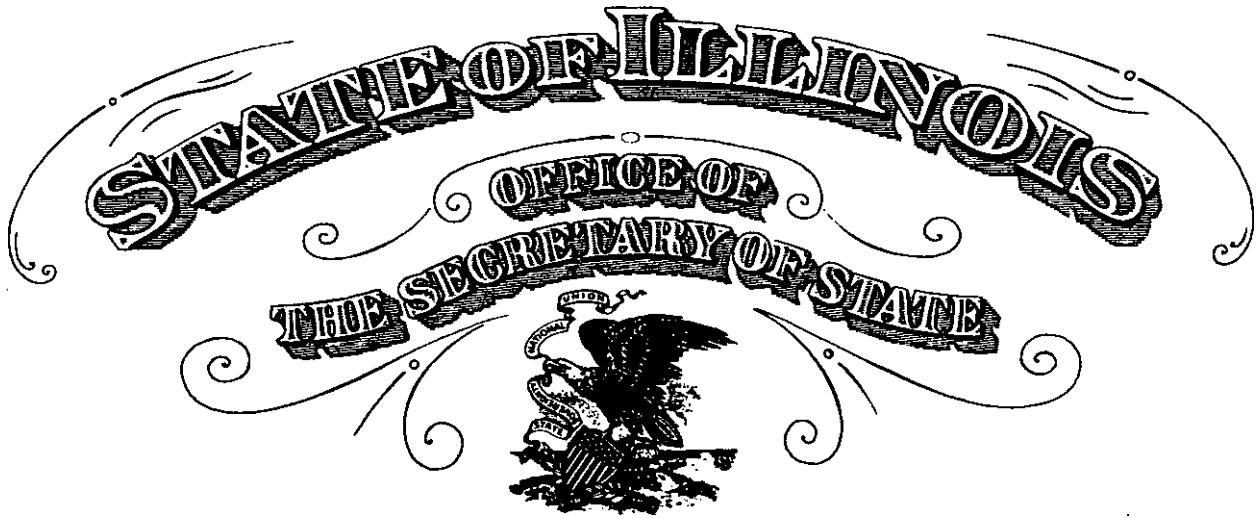

To elaborate on TMGES, INC., methods we will use to ensure all marketing is performed in an ethical manner, for both employees and subcontractors, it's best to start with our policy of, "open-book pricing." As Principal and founder of TMGES, Inc., Merrill Mangalasseril instituted a policy of disclosing our margin to our clients from A to Z. Our average margin on our entire book (550+ commercial accounts) is approximately 2.5 mils (aka \$0.0025/kWh), and to ensure that no subcontractors, or employees are gouging and/or inflating customers, every single energy contract is reviewed by Principal, Mangalasseril. We are not a high customer acquisition company. This December, 2019 will mark 8 years in business, and when we come across our 600th commercial client in 8 years, that means we're averaging a healthy 75 clients a year, and given our approach, we've been yielding a 97% retention on existing clients. To reiterate, TMGES, Inc., is a small company with only two employees: (1) Principal, Merrill Mangalasseril and (2) Operations Architect, Drew Pickerington. Currently, we are working with 5 subcontractors, in which, 4 of 5 are categorized as seasonal Referral Partners; however, as stated in Staffing Structure section, one of our subcontractors, Rintu Philip, has been with TMGES, Inc., for 4 years, and once again, all of his 190+ commercial clients were all reviewed by Principal, Mangalasseril.

Our policy of open-book pricing also maintains transparency between our subcontractors and employees. When they are aware of the gross margin, they are involved and CC'd in emails directly with our Channel Partners at their respective suppliers, so when an energy agreement is booked, our subcontractors are also CC'd on the booking receipt and confirmation. Furthermore, when Supplier's send us their commission statements, we disclose it all to our subcontractors, so this ensures that if there are any discrepancies, we can address them instantly and in many cases it's normally a supplier missing a payment, or an entry. It doesn't happen often, but does happen and is taken care of in swift and ethical manner.
