Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“I&E”) requests to withdraw the above-docketed Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against Ruperto Hernandez T/A Cachorro Transport LLC. (“Respondent”).

On April 11, 2018, I&E served the Complaint against Respondent for failure to maintain evidence of liability insurance. On April 25, 2018, the Commission received from Respondent evidence that Respondent’s entity name changed from Ruperto Hernandez/Cachorro Transport to Cachorro Transport LLC. Correspondence between I&E and the Commission’s Bureau of Technical Utility Services (“TUS”) revealed that Respondent timely caused its insurer to file evidence of liability insurance under its new entity name. Accordingly, due to Respondent having caused its insurer to file evidence of liability insurance with the Commission under Cachorro Transport LLC., I&E submits this petition to withdraw the Complaint.

A copy of this letter has been served on Respondent in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a), a party may object to this letter-petition within twenty (20) days of service. **If Respondent, Ruperto Hernandez T/A Cachorro Transport LLC., does not object to the withdrawal of the above-docketed Complaint then Respondent does not need to take further action.**
