2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the October 18, 2019 hearing date because of the unavailability of PECO witness, Senior Supervisor – Field & Meter Services, Patrick O’Neill.

3. Mr. O’Neill’s department has a mandatory, pre-scheduled Safety Training Program planned for the date of the hearing. Unfortunately, due to this unavoidable scheduling conflict, Mr. O’Neill is unavailable on the hearing date.

4. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.




