ORDER

By the Commission:

I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

On June 8, 2011, Maryland Energy Advisors LLC ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454 ("Part 454"). The Administrative Law Judge requested additional information and clarification of certain matters contained in the Application. The Applicant filed a verified response providing the requested information. Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Maryland and licensed to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data.

III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant submitted an original surety bond in satisfaction of Section 454.80.

Applicant is required by Part 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Part 454.60, as demonstrated in Attachment 1. Attachment 2 includes an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and identifying the persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a). Attachment 1 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Part 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Part 454.70 with the information provided, including the information included in Attachment 4. Attachment 4 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.70(a).

The Applicant indicates in its application that it is licensed as an Electricity Broker in Maryland; and that it has not had any complaints filed against it for its provision of services in the gas or electric industry.

Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Maryland Energy Advisors LLC is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Maryland Energy Advisors LLC, a business organized under the laws of Maryland, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) Maryland Energy Advisors LLC should be granted the certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Maryland Energy Advisors LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Maryland Energy Advisors LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

I. SUMMARY

In this Order, we license Maryland Energy Advisors, LLC d/b/a PointClickSwitch.com to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker service for residential, small non-residential, medium non-residential, and large non-residential customer classes throughout Central Maine Power Company, Emera-Bangor Hydro-Electric District, and Emera-Maine Public Service District territories pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On December 15, 2014, PointClickSwitch.com applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. PointClickSwitch.com proposes to provide aggregator/broker service for residential, small non-residential, medium non-residential, and large non-residential customer classes throughout Central Maine Power Company, Emera-Bangor Hydro-Electric District, and Emera-Maine Public Service District territories and has met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements.

As a licensed competitive electricity provider, PointClickSwitch.com is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports. Chapter 305 § 2(C)(3) also requires a competitive electricity provider to use reasonable efforts not to conduct business with any entity acting as a competitive electricity provider in Maine without a license from the Commission. Therefore, if PointClickSwitch.com uses a third party to market its services, it is responsible to ensure that the third party has met any licensing requirements of the Commission.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, *PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive*

Electricity Providers, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S. § 3203 (1)(2) and Chapter 305, § 2 to license competitive electricity providers. NOTICE OF RIGHTS TO REVIEW OR APPEAL

5 M.R.S.A. § 9061 requires the Public Utilities Commission to give each party to an adjudicatory proceeding written notice of the party's rights to review or appeal of its decision made at the conclusion of the adjudicatory proceeding. The methods of review or appeal of PUC decisions at the conclusion of an adjudicatory proceeding are as follows:

1. Reconsideration of the Commission's Order may be requested under Section 1004 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (65-407 C.M.R.110) within 20 days of the date of the Order by filing a petition with the Commission stating the grounds upon which reconsideration is sought. Any petition not granted within 20 days from the date of filing is denied.
2. Appeal of a final decision of the Commission may be taken to the Law Court by filing, within 21 days of the date of the Order, a Notice of Appeal with the Administrative Director of the Commission, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(1)-(4) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure.
3. Additional court review of constitutional issues or issues involving the justness or reasonableness of rates may be had by the filing of an appeal with the Law Court, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(5).

ORDER GRANTING LICENSE

On July 14, 2014, Maryland Energy Advisors, LLC ("MEA" or "Company"), filed an application with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a license to conduct business as an aggregator of natural gas and electricity ("Application"). In its Application, the Company seeks authority to serve commercial and industrial customers throughout Virginia.¹ The Company attested that it would abide by all applicable regulations of the Commission as required by 20 VAC 5-312-40 B of the Commission's Rules Governing Retail Access to Competitive Energy Services.

On July 23, 2014, the Commission entered an Order for Notice and Comment, which, among other things, docketed the case; required MEA to give notice to appropriate persons; provided for the receipt of comments from the public; required the Commission Staff ("Staff") to analyze the reasonableness of the Application and present its findings and recommendations in a Staff Report; and provided an opportunity for participants to file any reply comments to the Staff Report.

¹ Although MEA seeks to serve customers throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia, retail choice as authorized under Virginia law exists only in the service territories of Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., Washington Gas Light Company, Dominion Virginia Power, Appalachian Power Company, and the electric cooperatives. Access to industrial gas customers in other gas distribution service territories has existed under PERC authority since the mid-1930s.

On August 11, 2014, Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Virginia Power ("Dominion Virginia Power") filed a Notice of Participation.

On August 18, 2014, the Staff filed its Report, which summarized MEA's proposal and evaluated its technical fitness and financial condition. The Staff recommended that MEA be granted a license to conduct business as an aggregator of natural gas and electricity services to commercial, industrial and government customers throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia as the Commonwealth opens to retail access and customer choice. Neither MEA nor Dominion Virginia Power filed a response to the Staff Report.

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of the Application, participant comments, the Staff Report, and applicable law and our Retail Access Rules, finds that MEA's Application for a license to conduct business as an aggregator of natural gas and electricity should be granted, subject to the conditions set forth below, and that this case should be continued to accommodate the consideration of any subsequent amendments or modifications to the license granted herein.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:


(1) MEA is hereby granted License No. A-38 to provide competitive aggregation service for natural gas and electricity to eligible customers in the Commonwealth of Virginia as the Commonwealth opens to retail access and customer choice. This license to act as an aggregator is granted subject to the provisions of the Retail Access Rules, this Order, and other applicable law.

(2) This license is not valid authority for the provision of any product or service not identified within the license itself.

(3) This case shall remain open for consideration of any subsequent amendments or modifications to the license granted herein.

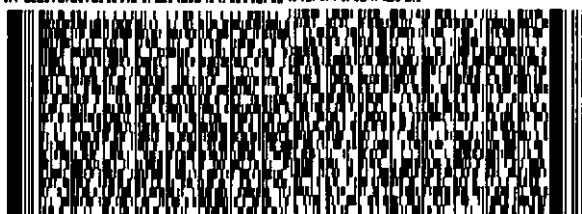
