2. On or about June 10, 2019, the Formal Complaint was served upon the Company.
3. On or about June 28, 2019, the Company filed its Answer to the Formal Complaint.
4. On or about July 2, 2019 the Commission ordered Company and Complainant to enter into a Resolution Conference.
5. The parties had the Resolution Conference, and reached a tentative settlement at that time, which required the complainant to pay down her balance to be eligible for a new payment arrangement.
