In accordance with the Interim Order Revising Initial Litigation Schedule issued on August 22, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as an updated status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("Company"). The Complainants were expected to submit their witness notification as required by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson's Interim Orders dated December 19, 2018 and August 22, 2019. As of this date, the Company has still yet to receive the Complainants' witness notification which was most recently due on September 20, 2019. At this point, the Company anticipates that Mr. and Mrs. Sabatini will only testify on their own behalf; as such, the Company intends only to present the testimony of Mr. John Ahr.

Counsel for the Company was not able to reach Mr. and Mrs. Sabatini to discuss their availability for a two-day hearing to be held in person in Pittsburgh. The Company avers that counsel for the Company and its witness are available the following dates: December 9-13, 2019. However, the Company notes that it believes one day will be sufficient to conclude hearings in this matter.


