
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on June 17, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Discovery has been completed and both parties have submitted their respective witness lists. Further, a prehearing conference was held on August 13, 2019. During the prehearing conference Mr. Konzelmann indicated that he was interested in potential relocation of his service. A relocation proposal was communicated to Mr. Konzelman on October 10, 2019 and Met-Ed is awaiting his response.

At the prehearing conference held in this matter, it was discussed that the parties expect to only need to present the testimony of the Complainant himself and that of Mr. John Ahr for Met-Ed, and the consensus was that a telephonic hearing is preferred. It was further anticipated that a hearing would be set for the November 4-20, 2019 timeframe. Met-Ed believes that one day should be sufficient to conduct an evidentiary hearing in this matter. To that end, Met-Ed is available during the contemplated window as follows: November 7, 15, 18 or 19.

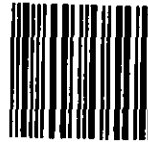
