In accordance with the Interim Order issued on June 18, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). Discovery between the parties has been completed. A prehearing conference was held on August 15, 2019. Ms. Dickun expressed an interest in West Penn's offer of relocation. The investigation into potential relocation is pending.

Further, Ms. Dickun stated that she would be presenting no expert and factual witnesses other than herself. As such, West Penn modified its witness list to only present one witness, Mr. John Ahr, in order to rebut any factual testimony offered at that time. Therefore, West Penn requests that an evidentiary hearing be scheduled. To that end, West Penn's counsel and witness are available on the following dates for such a hearing: November 1, 7, 15, 18, or 19, 2019; December 2, 6, 9-13, 16, or 18, 2019; or January 6-10, 13-17, 21-24, or 27-31, 2020.
