Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on September 4, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Met-Ed initiated discovery on February 8, 2019. Ms. Trieb failed to respond to West Penn's discovery. On March 12, 2019, West Penn filed a Motion to Compel which was granted by Interim Order entered by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Jeffrey Watson on March 28, 2019 and directed Ms. Trieb to respond to Met-Ed's discovery requests no later than April 12, 2019. No response was received from Ms. Trieb to the Motion to Compel or Met-Ed discovery requests in contradiction to the Interim Order entered on March 28, 2019. As a result, on May 9, 2019, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Dismiss. ALJ Watson issued an Interim Order on September 4, 2019, which held the Motion to Dismiss in abeyance and directed Mrs. Trieb to respond to Met-Ed's discovery requests no later than October 1, 2019. Further, the parties were each directed to provide a status report by October 15, 2019.

To date, no response of any kind has been received from Ms. Trieb in contradiction to ALJ Watson's Interim Orders. As such, Met-Ed respectfully requests to renew its Motion to Dismiss which was filed on May 9, 2019.

Alternatively, Met-Ed suggests that a prehearing conference be set for this matter in order to determine Ms. Trieb's intent in moving her complaint forward.
