
To the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

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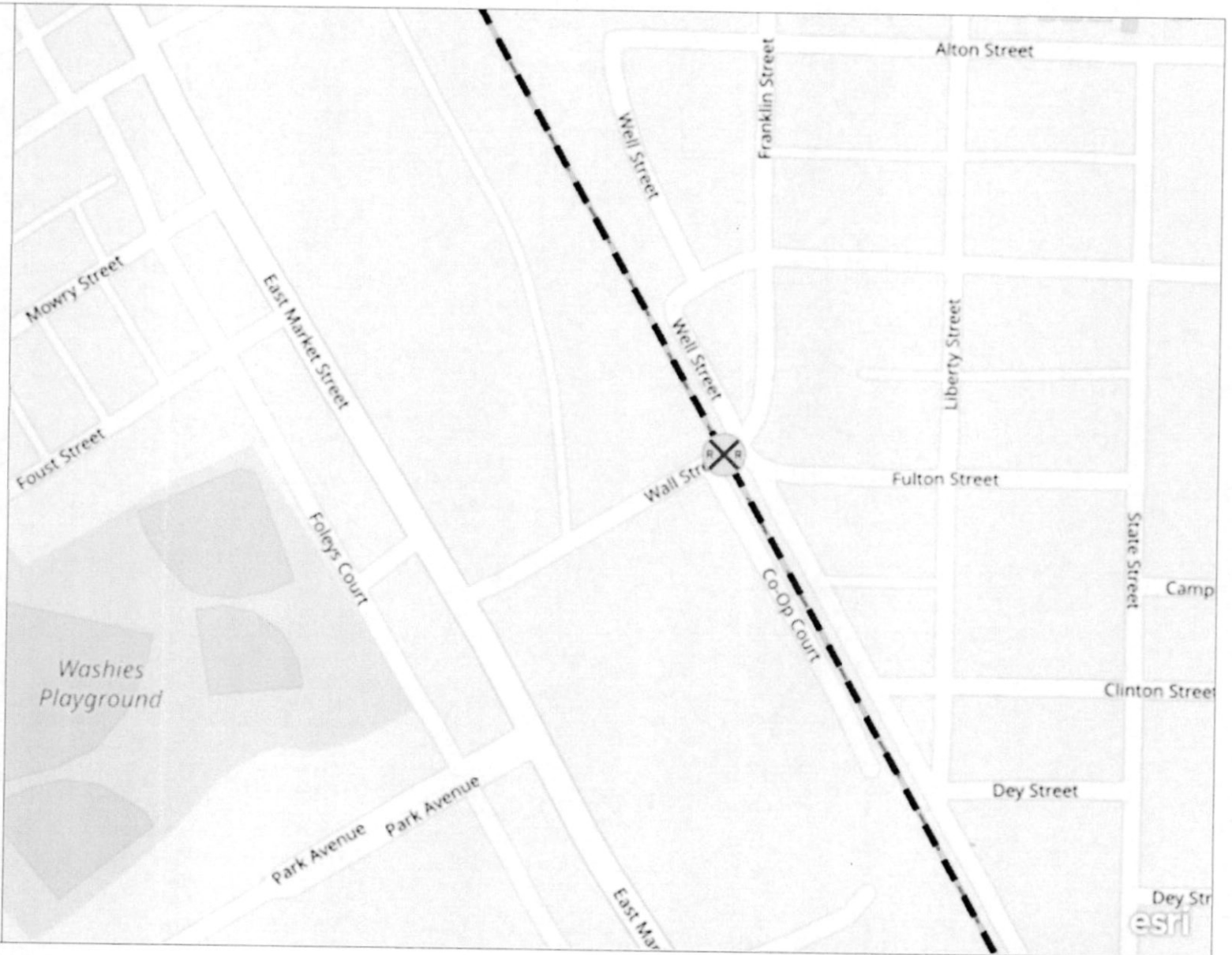

NSHR

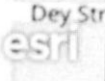
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NSHR Centerline

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

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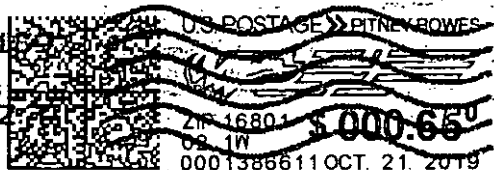
