
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on June 10, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as an updated status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). In accordance with that Interim Order, Met-Ed initiated discovery on June 17, 2019. Mr. Habrial failed to respond to Met-Ed's discovery. On August 13, 2019, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Compel which was granted by Interim Order entered by Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Jeffrey Watson on October 15, 2019 and directed Mr. Habrial to respond to Met-Ed's discovery requests no later than November 1, 2019. Mr. Habrial has provided no response to the discovery requests. Met-Ed has provided notification of its anticipated witnesses. However, Mr. Habrial has not provided notification of his anticipated witnesses.

At this point, Met-Ed recommends that a prehearing conference be set so as to ascertain Mr. Habrial's intent in presenting witnesses at an evidentiary hearing in this matter, as well as to make certain revisions to the procedural schedule in anticipation of evidentiary hearings.


