Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on September 24, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Company ("West Penn" or "Company"). On October 21, 2019, the Complainants served their Set I discovery on West Penn; however, the questions themselves were not attached. Mrs. Magill provided the questions via electronic mail on the evening of October 24, 2019, and the Company is actively working to either object or respond to those questions, as appropriate.

Meanwhile, counsel for West Penn has been in communication with Mr. and Mrs. Magill regarding available dates for the in-person two-day evidentiary hearing to be held in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Mrs. Magill has advised that January 2020 dates are not available for her witnesses, and she has provided dates in February 2020. Unfortunately, those dates are not available for the Company's witnesses. As such, West Penn has provided the following dates to the Complainants for consideration in March 2020: March 10, 17, 19, 26, 27, or 31. The Company is awaiting the Magills' feedback on those dates. West Penn is also available on the following dates in the first portion of 2020 for in-person hearings in Pittsburgh with all of its witnesses: January 16, 21 or 24; February 3, 5 or 7; and April 2, 7, 14, 21, 23, 28 and 30.


