

ATTACHMENT H – OVERSIGHT OF MARKETING

Oversight of Marketing

Aggressive Energy, LLC ("Aggressive Energy" or the "Company") provides structured fixed and index natural gas and electricity products to large commercial and industrial ("C&I") customers. Aggressive Energy does not actively market to prospective customers and does not utilize telemarketing, direct mail marketing, electronic and internet marketing, or door-to-door marketing at this time. Aggressive Energy engages energy brokers in order to procure new business.

All individuals and subcontractors hired by Aggressive Energy to communicate with prospective customers or to solicit or market its products and services will undergo training on Aggressive Energy's services and the retail energy market. All employee representatives must be trained before they are permitted to service or market to current or prospective customers. Training topics will include:

- 1) The development and current state of the deregulated retail competitive market, including licensing requirements and obligations, Aggressive Energy's role, and that of the local distribution utility ("LDU");
- 2) Knowledge of applicable laws, rules and regulations, including the Independent System Operators ("ISO") and LDU policies and procedures
- 3) iii. Knowledge and understanding of relevant sections of the Uniform Business Practices ("UBP"), with particular emphasis on UBP Section 10 (Marketing Standards) and Attachments 1-3 of Section 5 (Changes in Service Providers)
- 4) Applicable provisions of the Home Energy Fair Practices Act ("HEFPA"), where relevant
- 5) Products and services offered by Aggressive Energy, including rate structure, payment options, agreement terms, the customers' right to cancel, and applicable early termination fees
- 6) Requirements to provide a toll-free number to customers for billing questions, disputes, complaints, rescissions and cancellations; and
- 7) The respectful, professional, and informative manner that Aggressive Energy expects its representatives to use when communicating with prospective and current customers

Employees and subcontractors will also receive training on Aggressive Energy's standards of conduct. With respect to marketing activities, these include:

- 1) The representative must never make false or misleading representations, including misrepresenting rates or savings offered by Aggressive Energy
- 2) The representative must clearly identify himself/herself and state that he/she represents Aggressive Energy. The representative must never represent that he/she is an employee, representative, or acting on behalf of a distribution utility.
- 3) Where applicable, the representative shall provide any prospective residential customers with a copy of the ESCO Consumers Bill of Rights and any other materials required by law before making a sales presentation.

- 4) Should a representative market to a prospective residential customer in person, the representative must display his/her Aggressive Energy photo identification.
- 5) The representative shall cover all provisions in the Customer Disclosure Statement with a prospective customer.

Aggressive Energy's training will emphasize that all representatives are obligated to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, standards of conduct, and other Company guidelines provided during the Program, and that failure to comply will be grounds for disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment.

Training will consist of initial in-person instruction and written materials provided to new employee representatives, and two sessions per year of subsequent training to all employee representatives. As permitted by applicable law, subsequent training may be conducted through computer programs or telephonically.

Aggressive Energy will monitor its marketing practices to ensure that efforts are conducted in accordance with Aggressive Energy's best practices and standards of conduct. The Program requirements set out below are tailored to each specific type of marketing activity that Aggressive Energy may at some time employ. The Vice President or his designee will perform quality assurance checks of employees and subcontractors, and Aggressive Energy's Compliance Department will conduct additional periodic reviews, to ensure compliance with these requirements.


