Re: Affiliated Interest Agreement between PECO Energy Company, Delmarva Light & Power Company, and Atlantic City Electric, G-2019-3011693

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Secretarial Letter issued on October 9, 2019, the Commission approved the above-noted affiliate arrangement. In that letter, the Commission stated that: "PECO is required to provide a fully executed copy of this Agreement to the Commission within 30 days from the date of this Secretarial Letter."

PECO originally anticipated that, by about October 25, 2019, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("BPU") would complete its evaluation of Atlantic City Electric's participation in this Agreement. However, the BPU is still conducting its evaluation. Pending completion of that evaluation, PECO and its affiliates have not executed a written copy of the Agreement.

PECO will provide a copy of the executed Agreement to the Commission as soon as it is finalized and signed. If the executed Agreement is not available for filing by January 10, 2020, then PECO will file a written status update at that time.
