**Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.’s Notice of Compliance
R-2018-2647577**

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s Order dated August 8, 2019 (“August 8 Order”) in the matter at Docket No. R-2018-2647577, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia” or “the Company”) submits the following notice detailing its compliance with Sections 1502 and 2203(4) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 1502, 2203(4).

As it relates to Columbia’s billing practice regarding “on bill” billing service for non-commodity goods and services¹, the Commission concluded that “Columbia must either provide such a service to all entities that provide such non-basic services or must discontinue the “on bill” billing policy.” (August 8 Order at 3, *citing* Opinion and Order dated December 6, 2018, Docket No. R-2018-2647577). In is August 8 Order, the Commission further directed Columbia “to end its ‘on bill’ billing practice for CSP and Nicor within two customer bill cycles or the end of the contracts, whichever comes first.” (August 8 Order at 11). Accordingly, Columbia submits that it has complied with the Commission’s directives and Sections 1502 and 2203(4) of the Public Utility Code, by discontinuing its “on-bill” billing practice.

¹ Columbia had contracts with CSP and Nicor/PHS for on-bill billing access for non-commodity goods and services on Columbia’s bills. Columbia no longer contracts with or provides access to its bills for non-commodity goods and services.

As of September 30, 2019, Columbia's contract with Columbia Service Partners ("CSP") has terminated and CSP no longer has access to Columbia bills. Likewise, as of October 28, 2019, Columbia has terminated its contract with Nicor/PHS and Nicor/PHS no longer has access to Columbia bills. As of October 28, 2019, the Company has discontinued its "on-bill" billing practice.


