Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on July 1, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). West Penn initiated discovery on July 22, 2019. Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh failed to respond to West Penn's discovery. On August 27, 2019, West Penn filed a Motion to Compel. On August 29, 2019, a prehearing conference was held, at which Mr. Orvosh and counsel for West Penn appeared and participated. The Motion to Compel was held in abeyance in accordance with an interim order issued on September 3, 2019, and provided Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh with extended deadlines of September 20, 2019 to respond to West Penn's discovery and provide notice of their anticipated witnesses.

On September 19, 2019, Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh provided a single document and a flashdrive to West Penn, which West Penn was not able to access due to security protocols. In addition, the Complainants failed to timely provide notification of their anticipated witnesses. On September 30, 2019, West Penn filed an Amended Motion to Compel. On October 5, 2019, Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh provided proper service of their responses to the discovery requests and, on October 16, 2019, West Penn withdrew its Amended Motion to Compel.


To date, Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh have continued to fail to provide notification of their expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the September 3, 2019 Interim Order. West Penn timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses. At this point, West Penn anticipates that Mr. and Mrs. Orvosh will only testify on their own behalf; as such, West Penn intends only to present the testimony of Mr. John Ahr. Given this, it is recommended that the matter be moved forward for scheduling of a one-day telephonic hearing. To that end, West Penn's counsel and witness

would be available for such a hearing on one of the following dates: December 6, 9, or 16, 2019; and January 7, 8, 10, 13, 22-24, 27, or 29-31, 2020.
