Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on October 21, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Met-Ed initiated discovery on January 15, 2019. Mr. and Mrs. Licht eventually responded to West Penn's discovery. Therefore, discovery between the parties has been completed.

While Mr. and Mrs. Licht have failed to provide notification of their expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the December 14, 2018 Interim Order, when asked of the witnesses they intended to present at a hearing in this matter through discovery, they responded "none, have no witness." Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses. At this point, Met-Ed anticipates that Mr. and Mrs. Licht will only testify on their own behalf; as such, Met-Ed intends only to present the testimony of Mr. John Ahr.

Further, Met-Ed is in receipt of Mr. and Mrs. Licht's status report, which was hand delivered on October 31, 2019. Met-Ed defers to their request for an in-person hearing to be scheduled in Harrisburg. Counsel for Met-Ed and its witness are available on the dates suggested by Mr. and Mrs. Licht of February 24, 25 and 26, 2020.
